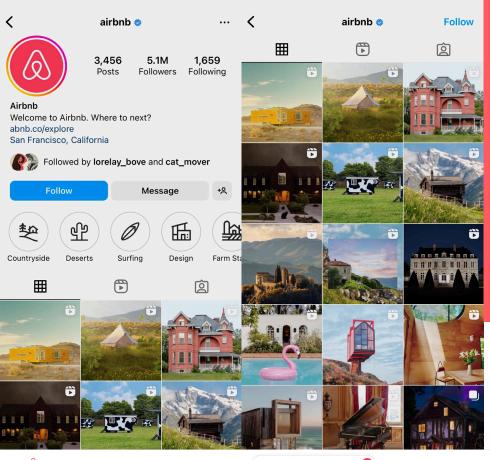

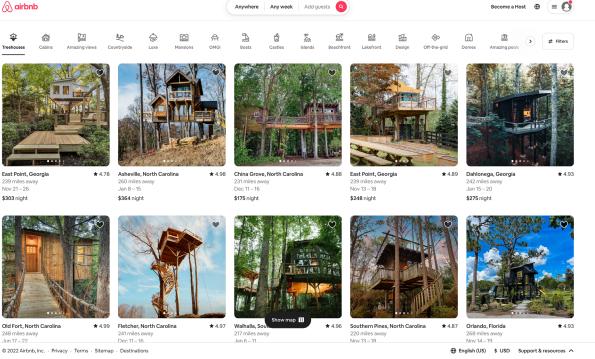

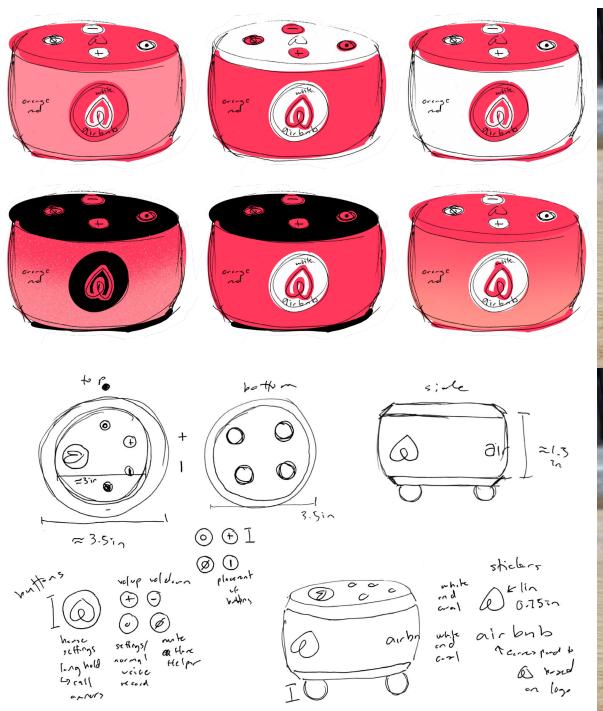
Airbnb's social media and website focuses on images. Both feature Airbnbs around the world.

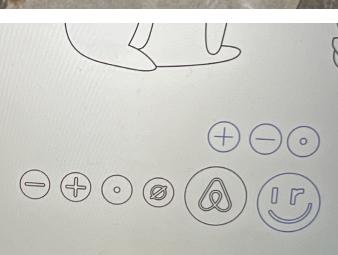

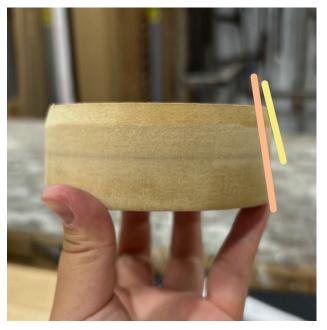




























Product Plan

House Helper

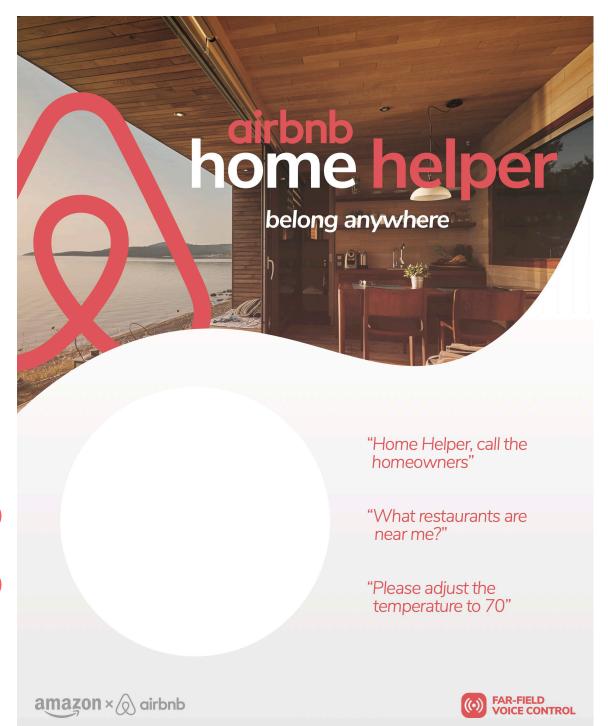
House Helper by Airbnb is meant to enhance your experience while traveling. Ask House Helper to lower the temperature in the house, turn on the lights, or even call the homeowner. Want to find out what 5 star restaurants are near you? Ask House Helper. House Helper performs all the functions of a regular Alexa while also being catered towards easing your Airbnb visit.





Button Functions

- airbnb button press to change the house settings, long press to call the owners
- + button volume up
- button volume down
- Ø button turns microphone on and off
- dot button activates device, can silence alarms, turns on set up mode



For my packaging, I wanted to blend Airbnb's brand with Amazon Alexa's.

After studying Airbnb's social media and website, I decided it would be best to use an image combined with their slogan, "Belong Anywhere."

Airbnb usually has very clean design, so I wanted to keep my packaging simple. To convey comfort and ease, I used rounded shapes and a slight pink gradient in the image to create a "dreamy" picture.

To tie my packaging to Alexa, I used the same elements that Echo Dot has on its packaging, but modified it to fit Airbnb.

I decided to add a grey gradient towards the bottom of the packaging to emphasize the white top of my product.







Reflection

I enjoyed this project a lot. I was able to combine graphic design, user experience, and industrial design all into one. There were a few hiccups, especially with printing the vinyl stickers, but it was cool to see it all come together in the end.
